SAPA welcome all visitors. We hold our regular meetings on Friday nights at 7:30 pm. We have programs given by our members, and other fun activities. We have an auction on the 2nd Friday of the month. It starts promptly at 7:30, so be there early to take a look at the lots. We also have a bourse night (like a flea market for stamps) on the last Friday of the month, which usually starts around 6:30 pm. We also encourage junior members to come.
